The history

Korea is located on the shore of the East China Sea, and it is above China.

Bronze Age: cultures who can use metal tools emerged in Korea. Prehistoric societies started to form in the Korean Peninsula, with evidence of settlements and groups.

Goguryeo, Baekje, and Silla were three big kingdoms that occupied most of the Korean peninsula. They had their own lands and leaders.

The Silla kingdom (from 600 years ago) united all of Korea under one rule. This was called the Unified Silla period, and it was a time of peace where there was no war.

A new kingdom named Goryeo was started which liked and learned Chinese ideas(especially Confucius's, a philosopher) and were known for their pottery.

1380s:General Yi Seong-gye became king and started the Joseon Dynasty. 1500s:Japan tried to take over Korea and there were big battles. Admiral Yi Sun-Sin defended Korea with special turtle ships and won important battles against the Japanese navy.

Japan became ultra-powerful and tried to rule Korea. This time they succeeded, ruling Korea from 1910 to 1945. They were liberated in 1945.

Korea was split into two countries:
Communist North Korea and Western South
Korea. In 1950 North Korea attacked the
South, resulting in a three year war and the
DMZ (Demilitarized Zone).

Today, North Korea and South Korea
follow different lines. South Korea has
become very advanced, while North
Korea has chosen to remain isolated.

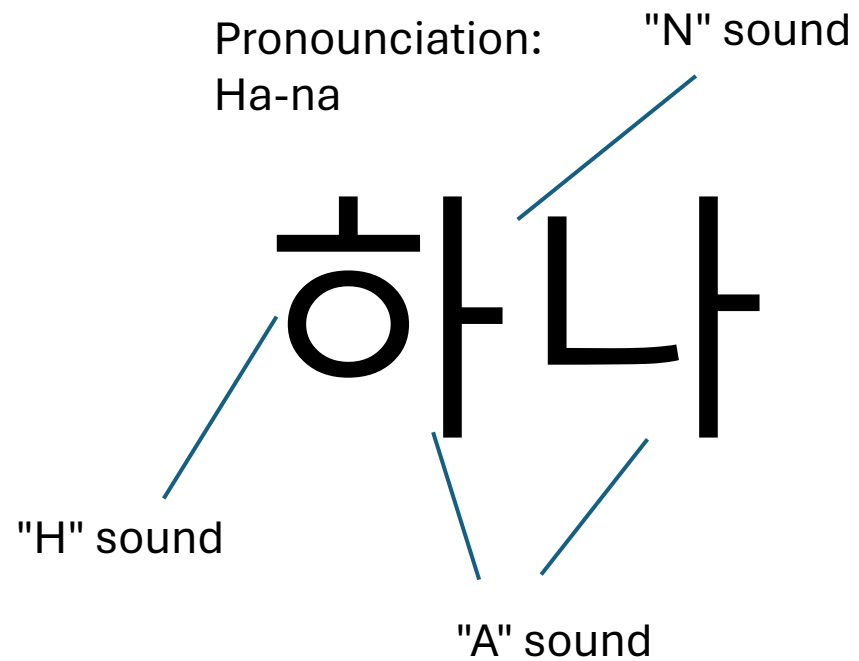

Korean is spoken as a first language by around 80 million people, including the Chinese and some of the Japanese. It is written in the Hangul script. It is based on a syllable-based written alphabet like many other languages. It evolved from the Chinese language. The syllable-based writing gives the language a rhythmic feel.
